MATERIAL

- Plain or printed yellow card
- Pink card
- A pencil
- Scissors
- A punch
- Paper doily
- Felt tipped pens
- Glue



1 Copy the body onto the yellow card (p. 30). Mark the two circles and go round the clothes.



2 Use the punch to make the two circle holes.

3 Make the neck of the clothes from the paper doily.



4 Draw (p. 30), cut out and stick the hands in place.

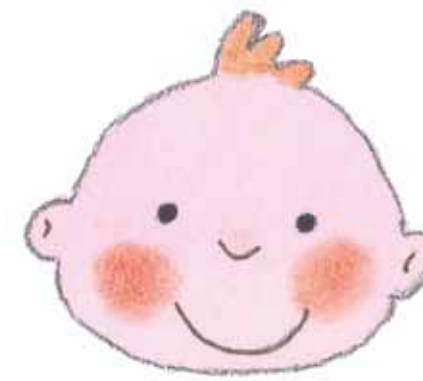
5 Copy the head and cut it out.

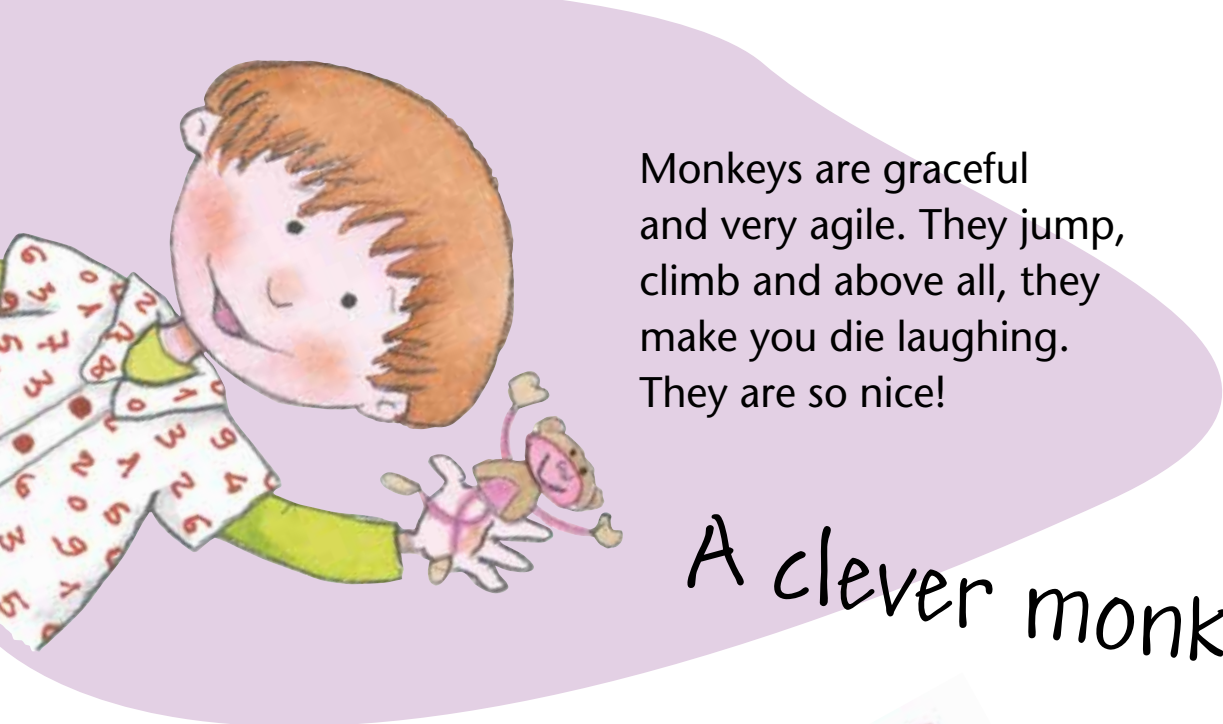
6 Draw the face and the hair. Give the baby some cheeks to make him look nicer!

7 Glue the head onto the body.



If you like, instead of a doily neckline, you can make a bib. Maybe this baby has already started eating puree!





MATERIAL

- Brown and pink card
- A pencil
- Scissors
- Glue
- Felt tipped pens
- Pink pipe cleaners

3 Glue the two pieces on the body.

4 Draw the nose and mouth.

1 Copy the monkey's body onto the brown card (p. 32) and cut it out.

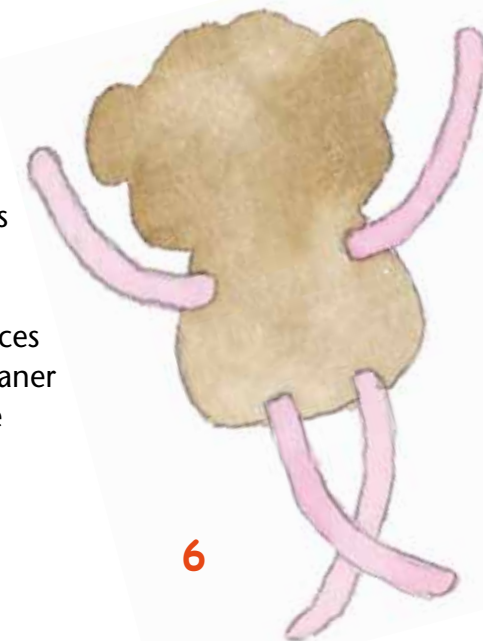
2 Copy the patterns for the snout and the belly (p. 32) onto the pink card and cut them out.

5 Draw the ears and eyes.

6 Stick four pieces of pink pipe cleaner behind to make the limbs.



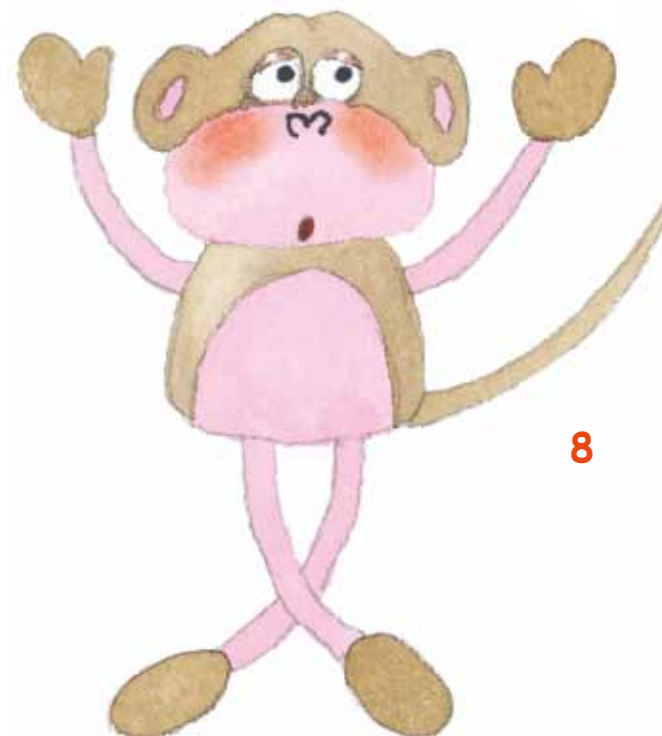

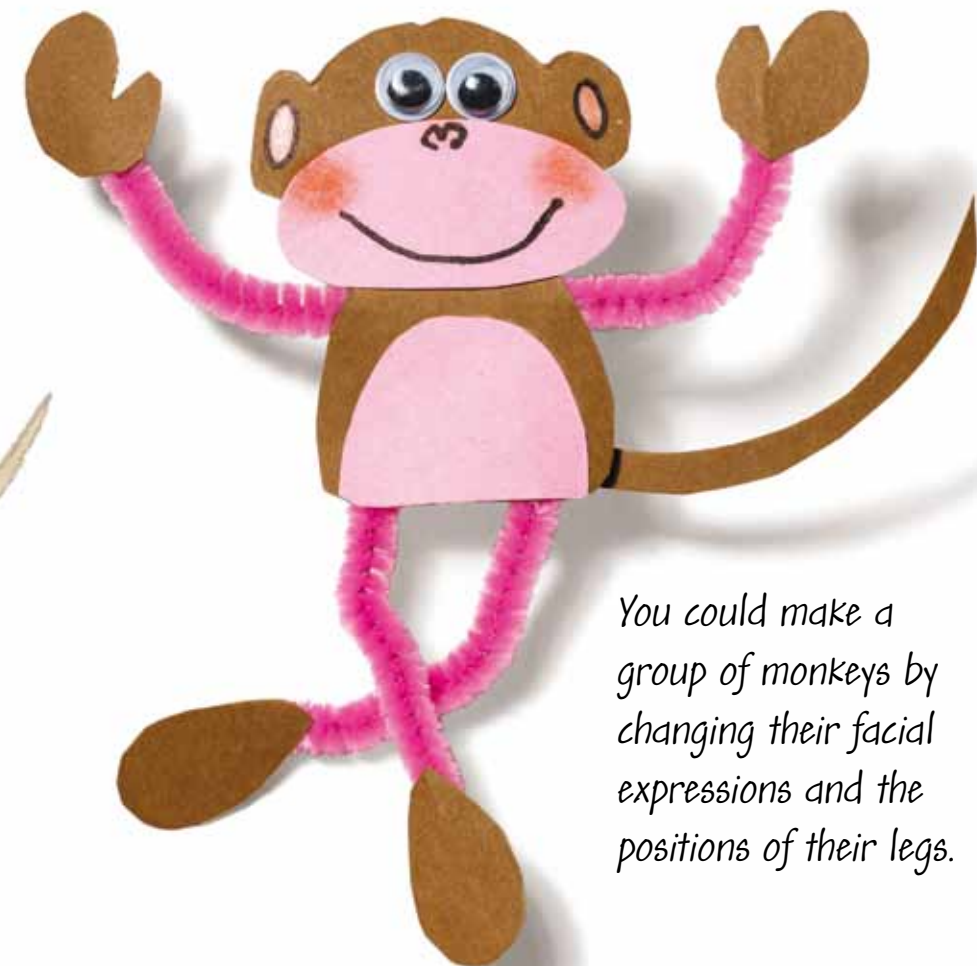

7 Make a paper ring the size of your finger and glue it onto the monkey's back.

8 Cut out the hands, feet and a very long tail and glue them on.

A little angel on Earth

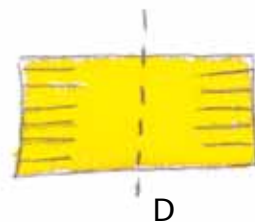
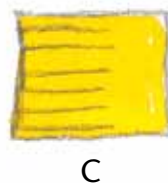
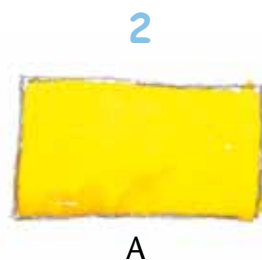


MATERIAL

- Pink card
- Yellow tissue paper
- Thick wrapping paper (such as kraft paper)
- Glue
- A pencil
- Black felt tipped pen
- Necklace string
- Beads
- Scissors

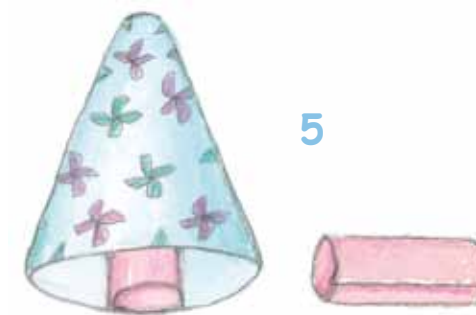
1 Copy the head and cut it out (p. 33).

2 Cut out a rectangle of yellow tissue paper 3 by 4.5 cm to make the ponytails (A). Fold them in half (B). Cut the fringes (C). Open the fold (D). Separate each half and roll it (E).



3 Copy and cut out the hair pattern. Glue it on the head and place the ponytails at the sides. Draw the face.

4 Copy the pattern for the dress, cut it out and glue it in a conical shape.



7 Draw, cut out and glue on the wings.

8 Join the head to the body.



And how do you imagine angels?
Add the decoration you like to the dress.

5 Place the ring for the finger inside the dress.

6 Thread two wooden beads onto the string and tie a knot. Do the same again and you have the legs. Glue them onto the dress.
